Thinkuknow is the national online safety education programme from CEOP, the online child protection command of the National Crime Agency. Thinkuknow helps parents, carers, teachers and others keep children safe from sexual abuse, offering learning activities, advice and support for children and young people aged 4-18 and their families. While school is closed, here's what you can do to keep your child stay safe while they are learning and having fun online.

1. Explore together
2. Chat little and often about online safety
3. Help your child identify trusted adults who can help them if they are worried
4. Be non-judgemental
5. Supervise their online activity:

7. Use 'SafeSearch'
