


What could you

Ewan " Today we went to the care home. There were people at the windows, all smiling at us. We showed them our pictures and then we put them in the letter box for them to keep."


Paige " We made a lovely lady very happy. She was smiling and laughing as we waved at her from the carpark."

Casey "Today made me feel very happy because it was nice seeing the people at the care home smiling. We waved, blew kisses and smiled back at them."


Junior "We went to the old people's home today. It was wonderful. We smiled, put up pictures and waved. The people were happy to see us and were smiling as they waved back."
